MY 20 YEARS

At Greenwich Millennium Village

LINDA PEARCE HAS LIVED AT GREENWICH MILLENNIUM VILLAGE SINCE IT WAS FIRST CREATED BACK IN 2000. SHE'S A MEMBER OF THE GREENWICH PENINSULAR COMMUNITY CHOIR AND A VOLUNTEER AT THE ECOLOGY CENTRE.

AS PART OF OUR 20 YEAR CELEBRATIONS, LINDA SAT DOWN WITH US TO DISCUSS LIFE AT GREENWICH MILLENNIUM VILLAGE.

Around the time the Millennium Dome was being built I saw an illustration of Greenwich Millennium Village in the Evening Standard. I thought it looked good and was in a great location.

I've lived in Greenwich all my adult life and always wanted to live by the river.

I went to a buyer's evening to see the model of the scheme. I love gardening so I knew I wanted something with the largest terrace. On sales launch day, I thought I'd beat the queues by arriving at 5.30 in the morning but other buyers had camped overnight! Luckily one of the sales staff helped me get my preferred home – she also lives here so I still bump into her after 20 years.

I bought off-plan which was quite a big risk but I've never regretted it. Before I moved in I used to come and check on progress. I have some brilliant pictures taken in 2000 – 2001. After I'd moved in the architect Ralph Erskine came to look around to check it had been well built. It was brilliant to meet him.

A MOVE CLOSER TO NATURE

I have got a fabulous roof terrace, with over 100 plant pots, and a separate balcony which overlooks the lake. I see all manner of birds such as goldfinches and greenfinches, starlings, little wrens, wagtails and sparrow hawks – plus our famous green parakeets.

In winter robins visit my bird-feeder; it's my own mini oasis.

I've seen the Ecology Park grow and flourish. I volunteer there one day a week. It's such an asset for our community, it's so peaceful to walk around here and with the park and the river, it doesn't feel like we're in the capital.

DISTINCTIVE DESIGN

The style of the architecture is so distinctive and it's great that so much is focussed on the Ecology Park – it's become the heart of the development.
